## A Preschooler May...

Rote count
Use fingers to represent numbers
Count familiar objects

Recognize quantities without counting
Compare objects and decide which has more, less or the same
Explore fractions such as half a cookie
Estimate the number of marbles in a jar
Recognize that if you have three friends you will need three cartons of milk (one to one correspondence)
Participate in number games
Adults May...
Sing counting songs and number rhymes with children (5 Little Monkeys for example)
Ask questions about how many such as "How many people are in the car?"
Read number books
Play number games that involve math concepts such as counting and number recognition
Divide a sandwich and talk about it in terms of fractions, such as "I have half the sandwich."
Use math language such as more, less and the same (equal)
Provide items for estimating (like marbles in a jar)
